Pilot Funding at UC San Diego I

Stein Center for Healthy Aging

Grants between \$10k - \$20k for projects related to successful aging, including imaging, genetics, neurocognition, and genomics

Clinical and Translational Research Institute (CTRI)

Grants between \$30k - \$50k for projects related to clinical and translational research, innovative technologies and community partnerships

Family Medicine and Public Health

Grants up to \$25k for FMPH faculty for a broad range of research topics

Academic Senate

Grants up to \$10k to support a wide range of faculty research projects



Pilot Funding at UC San Diego II

Krupp Endowed Fund For Integrative Medicine Research

Grants from \$50k to \$450k for projects on integrative medicine, with a particular focus on diet, medicinal food and herbs, and healthy lifestyle

Center for AIDS Research

Grants up to \$50k for HIV-associated malignancy research

Moores Cancer Center

 Three different grant programs, awards from \$30k to \$75k, collaborates with the American Cancer Society, funds collaborative translational research

Clinical Observership and Research Education Program

Grants up to \$12k for faculty to support international medical graduates, an opportunity to enhance their research experience
